Support for Stormy Seasons

First, remember a few things:

- Don't let what you see make you forget His promises and Words He's given you! This storm, this season is no surprise to Him; the promise still stands!
- Remind yourself of God's faithfulness in past storms and the fruit He created in you as a result. God can use anything for good if you allow Him to!
- If He brought you to it, He can bring you through it. But you determine by response if you thrive in process.

7 Tips for Storms:

- 1. Turn on the light and keep it on! Be honest with yourself and others about your situation and how it's impacting you.
- 2. Turn to The Light. Saturate yourself in the power of prayer and the word daily. This literally rewires your brain and perspective of life/storms! Have a list of scriptures handy for when you feel discouraged or overwhelmed; declare them aloud!
 - And stay in church. Keep it a priority. Don't take yourself out of the race just because conditions aren't favorable! Checking out of church won't do anything good for you!
- 3. Strengthen yourself in the Lord with worship! There's nothing like spirit lifting tunes and raising your voice in praise to reinvigorate a weary soul. Declare God's goodness and faithfulness out loud! It's biblical to have joy and gratitude right where you are in the midst of it all!
- 4. Take care of yourself. Rest in Him. Know your limits. Enlist help. Manage expectations. Adjust your schedule and priorities as needed in this season.
- 5. Get support. Assess what you may need and access the support immediately available to you. It's not a sign of weakness; it's a step towards your best you!
 - o Talk with a trusted individual.
 - Get help from the appropriate professional as is in your best interests. Access pastors and mental health professionals for counseling as needed.
 - o Join an in-person or online church bible study/life/grow group (Grief-share, Financial Peace, Propel, mom's groups, etc.).
 - Locate local community resources for basic needs. Try starting at your church or <u>United Way's 211</u>: Aspiring Christian <u>Resource Connection</u> tab if you need additional help finding resources!
- 6. Fix your focus. You often see what you look for. Search for the silver lining in all things! God is good!
- 7. Don't shortchange yourself by just turning to God when you have storms... make a habit of relying on Him through every situation and season so He can guide you and strengthen your faith, resilience and confidence to victoriously weather any storm!
